“The Hanover Park Barber Shop”

WHEREAS, Tony Perri, a barber from the South side of Chicago, came to Hanover Park in 1962; and

WHEREAS, in 1963, Tony Perri saw phase one of the new Hanover Park ‘N Shop Shopping Center (currently the Hanover Square Shopping Center) and opened the Hanover Barber Shop; and

WHEREAS, in 2001, after 38 years of serving the residents of Hanover Park and surrounding communities, Tony Perri retired; and

WHEREAS, as Tony Perri retired, Tony Ruffolo took over management of the day-to-day operations and assumed full responsibility of running the shop following the passing of Mr. Perri in July, 2002; and

WHEREAS, many of Hanover Park’s children received their first haircut from Tony Perri and have fond memories of him; and

WHEREAS, this year marks the 50th year for the oldest business still operating in the Village and retains the original name in honor of Tony Perri.
