## Coming to Hanover Park

### Education and Work Center



Following a successful collaboration between the Village, Elgin Community College, Harper College, and the Chicago Cook Workforce Partnership (workNet), an Education & Work Center is about to open its doors within the Hanover Square Shopping Center. This unique partnership is the first of its kind in Illinois, and will provide improved access to education to residents of Hanover Park and surrounding communities.

The consolidated community college and employment services extension site will offer adult basic and secondary education, English as a Second Language instruction, unemployment services, and educational planning assistance to residents in the area – for FREE.

The 10,900 square foot center will be located just to the left of the Hanover Barber Shop. It will include five classrooms, one workNet room, an administrative area, and a large common area.

Hours of operation will be from 8:00 a.m. to 9:30 p.m., Monday through Thursday and from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Friday. The class schedule will be available this summer. Stay tuned for more information in the July/August *Hi-Lighter*.

Congratulations to our Finance Department for, once again, receiving the prestigious Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA) Award for Excellence. 

### e-Cigarette Regulations

At their meeting of March 20, 2014, the Village Board passed Ordinance 14-10 regulating the sale of e-Cigarettes that included banning the sale of e-Cigarettes to minors.

### Noise Abatement Ordinance

The Village Noise Abatement Ordinance prohibits any unreasonably loud or raucous noises which disturbs another. The ordinance prohibits loud noises such as music, shouting and similar activities to be audible at a distance of 50 feet from a building or structure between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. No person shall play any radio or amplification system in a vehicle that can be heard at a distance of 75 feet or greater.

The Police Department will respond to all loud music and noise complaints. While officers will often issue warnings for first offenses, violators can be cited and fined up to \$750.00 for noise violations. 

# Finance Department

On March 20, 2014 the Village Board approved the Fiscal Year 2014B Annual Budget, which establishes authorized expenditures and sources of revenues from May 1, 2014 through December 31, 2014. Because the Village is in the process of converting from a fiscal year to a calendar year, a shortened eight month budget was necessary. Fiscal Year 2014B is that eight month transition budget.

In her Annual Budget message, the Village Manager stated that this budget document is in response to the needs of the citizens and business community of Hanover Park and is designed to provide a comprehensive overview of the Village’s financial activities during the next twelve months.



“Hanover Park continues its long tradition of delivering a balanced budget for Board approval. I appreciate the willingness of staff to continue to be frugal and mindful of the state of the economy, while still being sensitive to the needs of the residents, and providing high quality services.” said Village President Rodney Craig.

The total Village Budget expenditures for Fiscal Year 2014B are \$40,329,511. General Fund Fiscal Year 2014B expenditures total \$21,363,923. This year’s operating budget, which excludes debt service, internal transfers, capital outlay and internal service funds, is approximately \$32,099,064. General Fund operating expenditures total \$20,360,656.

**Village Approves Increase in Utility Tax.** The Village Board recently made a decision to increase the electric utility tax. Hanover Park previously had one of the lowest electric utility tax rates in the area amongst surrounding communities that impose the tax. While this increase will help bridge some of the gap in the projected 2015 budget deficit, the new rates will still be in line with rates charged by other comparable communities.

Increased rates will be based on tiers of usage and would apply to all customers. An average single-family household will likely see an increase of about \$3 a month from their current rate, which will be inclusive of ComEd's administrative fees.




