- Free phone service that provides information about inmates and court dates, and automatically notifies victims when an inmate is being released from custody

DuPage County Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE)

- Free phone service that provides information about an inmate's custody status and automatically notifies you when an inmate is being released from custody

DuPage County Victim Information and Notification Everyday (VINE) for Orders of Protection

(866) 559-8030 – toll free

- Free phone service that notifies victims if an Order of Protection has been served, and gives updates on court dates

Illinois Automated Victim Notification (AVN)

(866) 566-8439 – toll free

- Free 24-hour statewide phone service that provides information about an inmate's custody and case status, and automatically notifies you of any change in status.
