MINUTES

1. CALL TO ORDER – ROLL CALL:

Trustee Liaison James Kemper called the meeting to order at 6:06 p.m.

2. ACCEPTANCE OF AGENDA:

Motion by Eric Gustafson to accept agenda. Second by Susan Bitte. Voice Vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

3. PRESENTATIONS/REPORTS:

None.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTE:

Motion by Susan Bitte to approve minutes of November 12, 2015 meeting. Second by Eric Gustafson. Voice vote: All ayes. Motion carried.

5. ACTION ITEMS:

5-a. Deputy Chief Johnson stated how the Red Cross has done the demonstration process of the install of smoke detectors. It doesn't require any further training as members can train those who were unable to attend. Trustee Kemper asked Eric Fors when the kick-off date is. May 1st for the public, but members will "practice" install on members' homes prior. Residents can be canvassed and have a set up date within in a 2-3 week timeframe. Nancy Cicero stated only two CERT members McBride & Aburto were interested besides Fire Corps members for install.

Deputy Chief Johnson sent our plan over to the National Safety Council and they were very impressed. Preliminary plans are being made for an emergency readiness Expo that will take place here in town at Menards in September. Notice of the Expo will be made at Village events and via social media.

5-b. If there is a need for a second CPR Spanish class, Chief Fors asked for a 3-week advance notice. Trustee Kemper will follow up to determine the number of people who are interested, if any.

5-c. Deputy Chief Johnson requested input on suggestions for possible Spring Training topics. Under consideration are Search & Rescue, PowerPoint presentation on Triage, and Active Shooter.

6. TOWNHALL SESSION:

No one registered to address the Citizen Corps Council.

7. OLD BUSINESS (NON-ACTION ITEMS):

Spanish CPR as discussed above.

8. NEW BUSINESS (NON-ACTION ITEMS):

Mayor Craig spoke provided a Village update. There is a possibility of a new DUCOMM facility near the county building. The Village has experienced a low crime rate for sixth year in a row! He also provided an update on his activities and involvement with outside agencies/organizations including Metra, ComEd and Bloomingdale.

Chief Fors mentioned reaching out for Basic CPR training to residents. No card, no cost, just basic instruction for residents to follow.

Next meeting is May 26th.
