7. OLD BUSINESS (NON-ACTION ITEMS):

7a. Veterans Memorial Update –

- Contract signed with sculptor, Bruce Neimi, and will hold cost to price quoted in January.
- Postponed construction to start on 5/14. Will remove current landscaping & replace walkway but will remain current flagpole until after Memorial Day.
- Veteran's brick will be 12x6 in lighter brown color with dark etching. The bricks will have 3 lines, 18 characters per line indicating name, rank and optional 3rd line. Veteran's bricks will be \$40.00.
- Friends of the Village brick will be 8x8 in sandstone color. These bricks will be used for special memory, occasion, tribute, etc. These will have 4 lines with 13 characters per line and will cost \$100.00 per brick.
- Corporate bricks will be 8x8 for \$500 or 16x16 for \$1000.00 with logo on larger brick. These will be in off-white.
- All bricks will be removable. Possibly order forms could be mailed with water bills in addition to advertise on website and the Comcast channel.
- Additional funding: Service flagpoles and larger flagpole can be purchased from \$3400 - \$4000; Benches at \$2000 and Service Medallions at \$500 each. Recognition for these additional funding is still being reviewed.
- Our verses can either be engraved in stone or put on a plaque. Will review options.

7b. Memorial Day update

- VFW & Boy Scouts will post colors and will do 13 point fold. Adrian will do Taps, Pastor Frank for prayers and Kendra will sing. Gospelites are not available. Mayor, Rick, Ron Moser and Bill Cannon will speak and any other Trustees are welcome.
- Will set up 100 chairs in parking area facing Village Hall. Parking will be in rear of building.
- Will have Cert Team directing traffic.
