Open Discussion: Met with Dan Dalziel from 3-D Design

- **The Memorial location will be in front of Village Hall. All current landscaping, including bushes, trees, brick edging and pavement will be removed.**
- **Dan presented us with 3 drawings and all agreed on the 3rd drawing "C".**
- **C drawing is in "C" shape consisting of 5 Service Memorials and the designated branch of service emblem on front of each monument.**
- **Monument of choice was a sand-colored stone with small wall connecting all 5 monuments.**
- **It was agreed to have 5 flag poles of each service flag behind each monument. The 5 flag poles will be 15' – 18' high each flying the individual branch of service.**
- **There will be a single 25' flag pole behind the 5 flag poles and monuments to fly both the American and POW flag.**
- **It was suggested to have brick paths leading up to each stone monument. These bricks could be purchased by residents to honor loved ones and could be laid per branch leading up to corresponding service branch monument. We could also have a separate area close by to honor any Corporations that donated funding for this Memorial.**
- **A stainless steel "statue" (designed by Ken Griesmer) will be placed in front of the bricked monuments. This "statue" will represent an eternal flame and a light will be placed in center to help visualize this as an actual flame. This light could flicker with various colors to grasp the effect.**
- **The area around the eternal flame could be paved with special type of pavement, which could be colored and textured.**
- **A special saying could also be inscribed and initiated around the tallest flag pole.**
- **There will be a landscaped area with an area for 2 benches.**
- **The area that is currently directly outside the Village Hall entrance could also consist of a sitting area and/or landscaped.**
- **The original sketch for drawing "C" was facing Village Hall. It was agreed that this should be turned 90 degrees so this Memorial would be viewed from the street.**
- **The entire area should have a walk way around and through the Memorial so this can be viewed by visitors.**
- **In addition, the entire area can be lit up and illuminated at night.**
- **Dan took down all notes and suggestions, did a short re-design, and will computerize another drawing that will be more in depth and a 3-D effect.**
- **Another meeting will follow at a later date.**
