- 5-b. “Keepsake” items – We discussed the cost and Linda said she would work with Mary to see if something nice – but very reasonably priced – could be obtained. Recommendations were coffee mugs, manicure sets, and calendar or note pads.
- 5-c. Mailing list for invitations – Members indicated they had turned in their lists to either Katherine or to Linda. Linda said we had over 100 names to send out next week. She encouraged everyone to add to their list if possible.
- 5-d. Review mock-up of invitation, program – Linda showed the group the final draft of the invitation, approved by the Village’s editorial board.
- 5-d. Entertainment, sound system requirements
  - Frank has not gone to the Seville yet to check on the type of sound system they have available, but will do that in the next few weeks.
  - Frank has been in touch with the dance ensemble and their organizer has committed to the date. Linda will follow up with her to be certain she knows when to arrive at the Seville.
  - Frank confirmed that the two young Hanover Park sisters will sing the National Anthems of Ghana and the US.
  - Pamela asked for clarification of the honorarium for Mary’s accompanist.
