Update: Cortese received e-mail regarding Core Council's quarterly training meeting is June 22nd with 2 sessions (11-3 pm and 1-4 pm). Phil verbally committed to attend. Mayor Craig asked of status of grant. Chief Cortese is not sure and will seek out info from Chief Webb. Had \$4,500 and not sure if same amount is available


