7a. Veterans Memorial Update –

- Bids came in well under budget but does not include eternal flame or medallions.
- Bricks – it was decided to have 4” x 8” brick size which would consist of 3 lines with 12 characters each. Name on first line, rank on 2nd line and optional sying on 3rd line. The veteran’s bricks will be a different color than family/corporate bricks. The family and corporate bricks will be in 2 separate areas. Howard will be meeting with a company later in week and they will supply samples.
- Eternal Flame – it was chosen to have the taller flame, which was somewhat narrower with one single taller “flame”. The cement base of the flame will be 3 ft. high and the flame structure will be 7’ high.
- 2 verses were chosen:
 - “We May Have Not Known Them, But We Will Always Remember Them” will be around the actual flame.
 - “On Land, on sea or in air, They always have and always will defended our life, liberty and pursuit of happiness” will be in the entrance of the actual Memorial.
